



$$157\frac{1}{7}\% = 100\% + 57\frac{1}{7}\% = 1 + \frac{4}{7} = \frac{11}{7}$$

Find the fraction value of $616\frac{2}{3}\%$

$$616\frac{2}{3}\% = 600\% + 16\frac{2}{3}\% = 6 + \frac{1}{6} = \frac{37}{6}$$

Find the fraction value of $208\frac{1}{3}\%$

$$208\frac{1}{3}\% = 200\% + 8\frac{1}{3}\% = 2 + \frac{1}{12} = \frac{25}{12}$$

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
