

Very important Points

 DI/Caselet DI & Puzzles/seating arrangements Part is of huge weightage in Quant and reasoning respectively so you have to solve 2-3 DI and 2-3 Puzzles/seating at alternate days to get command.
After completing 60% syllabus, you can start writing Mock tests once or twice in week and work

on your weak areas as per analysis.

3. Agriculture in mains is a game changer so Attempt mock tests for mains for sure.

4. Try to Read newspapers daily for improving Reading.

5. If exam is nearby, you can cover topics speedily and you have to give daily more time to study and if you have enough time for exam, then you should do every topic with very basics, try to solve all types of Q with a lot of practice.

6. All topics equally important for Quant, Reas & Eng for Pre as well as Mains so you cannot take a chance to miss any topic. But in pre-exams, level will be easy to moderate, so you can skip very difficult problems but after pre-exam, you just have to focus on Higher level problems as Mains exam is going to be very tough.
